



NOTIFICATION OF A SCHEME
Professional Standards Act 1994 (NSW)

Notification is hereby given pursuant to Section 8 of the *Professional Standards Act 1994* (NSW) of a scheme prepared by the Professional Surveyors Occupational Association (the Association). The scheme:

1. applies to all members of the Association;
2. is proposed to operate in New South Wales and in the Australian Capital Territory, Queensland, Victoria and the Northern Territory;
3. limits the occupational liability of members of the Association to three categories, \$1million, \$2million or \$5million depending on the class of membership;
4. confers a discretionary authority on the Association, on application by a member, to specify in relation to that member a higher maximum amount of liability than would otherwise apply, up to \$30million; and
5. requires members to have insurance for occupational liability of an amount not less than the amount of their limited liability.

The Association requires that its members to whom the scheme applies comply with relevant risk management strategies, scheme disclosure requirements and other quality assurance arrangements.

The scheme may remain in force for a period of up to 5 years.

A copy of the scheme may be obtained from, or inspected at, the Office of the Professional Standards Councils, or on the website of the Professional Standards Councils.

Before approving the scheme, the Professional Standards Council of New South Wales hereby invites comments and submissions to be made in writing and received by the Executive Officer, Professional Standards Councils, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
