



NOTIFICATION OF A SCHEME
Professional Standards Act 2004 (Qld)

Notification is hereby given pursuant to Section 9 of the *Professional Standards Act 2004* (Qld) of a scheme prepared by the Bar Association of Queensland (the Association). The scheme:

1. applies to any barrister who holds a Queensland practising certificate issued under the *Legal Profession Act 2007* (Qld) or regulations made under it, is a member of the Association and is insured under an approved professional indemnity insurance policy which complies with the requirements of the *Legal Profession Act 2007* (Qld) and regulations;
2. is proposed to operate in Queensland, and in New South Wales, the Australian Capital Territory, Victoria, South Australia, Western Australia, and the Northern Territory; and
3. limits the occupational liability of members of the Association to whom the scheme applies to an amount of \$1.5 million.

The Association requires that its members to whom the scheme applies comply with relevant risk management strategies, scheme disclosure requirements and other quality assurance arrangements.

The scheme may remain in force for a period of up to 5 years.

A copy of the scheme may be obtained from, or inspected at, the Office of the Professional Standards Councils, or on the website of the Professional Standards Councils.

Before approving the scheme, the Professional Standards Council of Queensland hereby invites comments and submissions to be made in writing and received by the Executive Officer, Professional Standards Councils, within 28 days of the publication of this notice.
