



NOTIFICATION OF A SCHEME
(*Professional Standards Act 1994 (NSW)*)

Notification is hereby given pursuant to section 8 of the *Professional Standards Act 1994 (NSW)* ("the Act") of a Scheme prepared under the Act by CPA Australia Ltd ("CPA Australia"), whose business address is Level 20, 28 Freshwater Place, Southbank Victoria 3006.

The proposed Scheme will apply in New South Wales and in all other states and territories of Australia, under the mutual recognition provisions of the professional standards legislation.

Participants in the proposed Scheme are all CPA Australia members who hold current Public Practice Certificate issued by CPA Australia.

The proposed Scheme limits the occupational liability of participants for damages arising from a claim to the extent to which the liability results in damages exceeding \$2 million. The monetary ceilings applicable to participants range from \$2 million to \$75 million, according to the category of service provided by the participant. The proposed Scheme provides for CPA Australia to approve, on application by a participant, a higher monetary ceiling than would otherwise apply, up to a maximum of \$75 million.

The proposed Scheme is intended to commence in NSW, and in the other applicable jurisdictions pursuant to the provisions of their respective professional standards legislation, on 23 December 2019. The Scheme may remain in force for a period of up to 5 years from its commencement.

Before considering the Scheme for approval, the Council hereby invites comments and submissions to be made in writing and received by the Chief Executive Officer, Professional Standards Councils, within 28 days of the publication of this notice. A copy of the Scheme may be obtained from or inspected at the office or website of the Professional Standards Councils.
